Substitute Library Employees Needed


Fort Vancouver Regional Library is currently recruiting for substitute employees for Goldendale Community Library and several other libraries in the Gorge. Applications are being accepted for Library Assistant II, Maintenance Assistant II, and Senior Library Assistant substitute pools. Successful candidates will be placed on an eligibility list for training and filling of substitute hours at one or more branches of FVRL.

Library Assistant II positions perform general public service and circulation duties in the Library. Senior Library Assistants will be expected to assist with and plan programs for adults and children and provide outreach services in addition to all the general public service tasks of a Library Assistant II. Maintenance II positions perform a variety of maintenance tasks including but not limited to landscape care, small item repair, building safety checks, working with hand and power tools, and more. To apply for current vacancies and be placed on our eligibility lists for substitute hours and future openings, please go to FVRL's website fvrl.org, click on 'About FVRL' at the bottom of the page, and then 'Jobs & RFP's'.
