Thank you to the Friends of Goldendale Community Library for sponsoring our inaugural Adulging 101 series this fall. The series was organized and administered by Goldendale Community Library and Klickitat County WSU Extension 4-H Program.

We hoped to teach young people some skills to help them on their path to being healthy citizens of our community, and our surveys show that we accomplished that goal for those who participated.

Sixteen young people participated in the 4 week program that included sessions on money management, healthy relationships, voting, and nutrition, cooking and self-care. These sessions included resources, activities and presentations from experts in the areas we covered. A light dinner was provided each week and students at the high school could gain community service hours for attending.

Volunteers from the community contributed approximately 80 hours of their time to share their expertise and resources with the young participants.

It was heartening to see the amount of care our community has for its young people. I don't think we were expecting the level of enthusiasm and engagement we received from our community leaders, our high school, and our local businesses and organizations.

We hope to make this an annual series that helps us in our mission to strengthen our community through knowledge, experiences, and creativity.
