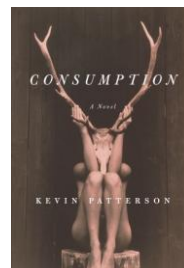
Our agenda for January includes:

**Resumes January 4, 2012.** Ages 0-3 years. Stories and play for babies and toddlers with caregiver. Wednesdays at 11 am.



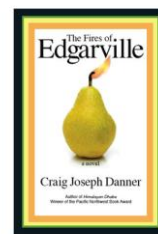
